- Our Journeys are designed to activate the people of Parker Hill Community Church. If there is room on the team, people from outside Parker Hill will be considered.
- These Journeys are for adults (18 and older) and families (students and a parent).
- Because of the extreme poverty and heart-breaking situations, we recommend that parents only bring children over 10 years of age. (This is simply a recommendation.)
