**FAMILY LIFE:** Our family is very involved in Family Ministries here at Parker Hill. Madeline (15) works in Mungu Land, Gabe (13) is a puppeteer, and my husband Todd is a Host in Epic Kidz. I am so glad that we all have the opportunity to be part of helping families find the way back to God and also helping children as they begin this journey.

### HOW DID YOU COME TO ATTEND PARKER HILL AND HOW LONG HAVE YOU BEEN ATTENDING?

We moved back to this area 5 years ago and have been attending Parker Hill for most of that time. It was good to come to a place where there were many familiar faces and the Word of God is taught in a way that is so relevant to our lives.

### HOW ARE YOU CURRENTLY "USING WHATEVER" AT PARKER HILL?

I have had the opportunity of working in Mungu Land for the past year as a worship leader. I enjoy this ministry because the children make me smile each week. It is such a joy to see them singing songs to Jesus and saying the verses that they learn each month. These young kids are like sponges, they love to learn and repeat the message of Jesus and His love!

### WHAT HAVE YOU LEARNED ABOUT YOURSELF AS A RESULT OF "USING WHATEVER" AT PARKER HILL?

I am one part of the whole picture of things that are happening here in Mungu Land. There is a group of us working to get the message out each week and it is so nice to come and work together and know that each one has a special part to play in reaching these little ones for Jesus. ### WHAT ADVICE CAN YOU GIVE TO SOMEONE WHO IS TRYING TO FIGURE OUT HOW THEY CAN "USE WHATEVER" AT PARKER HILL?

Try something, even if it's new for you. Sometimes you are surprised at how God can use you. It's so neat to realize that it's not you, but totally God doing His work through you! He is looking for a willing heart, and as we give that to Him, He will use us in ways that we could never have imagined.

## *Do you serve better BEHIND THE SCENES?*

**Weekday Facility Prep (Ministry Prep)** - House-keeping done early in the week that prepares ministry areas for weekly programs. Volunteer once a month or as much as once a week.

**Bulletin Stuffers & Alternates (Communication)** - Looking for volunteers who can serve regularly or alternates to fill in when others are not able to serve. Bulletin stuffers serve every Saturday afternoon at the Dickson City Campus.

**Saturday Facility Prep (Ministry Prep)** - This is a great behind-the-scenes opportunity to welcome guests as we get the campus ready for our weekend gatherings.

**Ride Provider (Care)** - This is an opportunity where you can serve others in a practical way by providing rides. Volunteers are needed who can provide one-time rides (such as doctor appointments) or weekly rides to worship gatherings).

**Check-in Host (Epic Kidz)** - Volunteers are needed to help families check-in their kids during all worship gatherings.

**Clarks Summit Chair Team (Ministry Prep)** - Stay for a few minutes after the 11:15 worship gathering to help prepare for the next ministry event.

**Care Connection (Care)** - Many people within our church face serious situations which at times need urgent and sometimes immediate prayer. If you would like to support others in this way, you can be put on a list to receive these requests by e-mail.

**Building Closer (Ministry Prep)** - Walk through the building turning off lights, and securing the building after our weekend gatherings.

**Shuttle Host (First Impressions)** - Greet and thank those that take the shuttle to the Clarks Summit Campus. Great ministry for those that like the outdoors and are willing to serve in all kinds of weather. Serve one month on, two months off starting in April. Serve from 10:30-11:15 at the shuttle parking lot.

**Dickson City Parking Team (First Impressions)** - Do you enjoy the outdoors and like telling people what to do? You even get your own safety vest/coat and a walkie-talkie!

**Usher (First Impressions)** - Are you good at finding and collecting? You can help people find good seats and collect the gifts for God! Ushers are needed at DC 6, DC 11:15, & CS 11:15!

**Small Group Leader (Epic Kidz)** - Volunteer and teach in a classroom where you can have a direct impact in the lives of young children whether in a permanent or substitute capacity. Since we provide curriculum, support, and training, previous experience is not required. Parents are especially encouraged to consider serving in this way.

**Greeter (First Impressions)** - Can you do two things at once? SMILE and open the door or hand out a bulletin! Greeters are especially needed at DC 9:30 & CS 11:15!

**Nursery Worker (Mungu Land)** - Friendly volunteers (including students, dads, grandparents) are needed to serve in the nursery during the Sunday worship gatherings. Fixed and rotating schedules are available. Substitutes and volunteers are needed at both campuses! Nursery workers are especially needed at CS 9:30!

**Host Crew (Kidz Jam)** - Help greet and direct our kids and families as they arrive at Kidz Jam each month.

**Welcome Host (First Impressions)** - Do you like knowing everything, answering questions and helping people find where they need to go? Man the Welcome Center or be a Foyer Floater! Welcome Hosts are especially needed at DC 9:30 and CS 11:15!

**Scranton Rescue Mission (Go Local!)** - Small groups are also needed to provide hot meals at either the Scranton or Wilkes-Barre Rescue Missions. Consider recruiting your family and friends to make and serve a meal on a Friday, Saturday, Sunday or Monday evening.

**Clarks Summit Shuttle Riders (First Impressions)** - Want door to door service? Provide open parking places for first time guests at the Clarks Summit campus by riding the shuttle bus from Myers, Briar & Kelly Law firm on Abington Road. Receive a free drink coupon every week for riding the shuttle!

**Small Group Leader Substitutes and Floaters (Epic Kidz)** - Small group leader substitutes are needed to be trained and fill in on an as-needed basis. Floaters are also needed to come each week and help out in whatever class has the greatest need that week.
